Collection Times:

Your collection day will be **Tuesday** in 2023. All items must be placed at the curb **no later than 6 a.m.** on the day of collection. After collection, any carts used for trash or recycling should be removed no later than the evening of your collection day.

Inclement Weather

Severe winter weather can be a challenge to our daily operations. When possible, we may also notify you by phone or email if your collection route is canceled or will be delayed.

Restricted Items:

The following items will not be collected as part of your regular waste and recycling collection:

- Construction/demolition materials
- Automotive parts
- Dirt, stone, concrete, rock
- Medical wastes
- Materials from fires or evictions
- Tires
- Antifreeze

Waste Management offers a convenient service for residents to properly dispose and recycle household hazardous waste - safely, easily, and responsibly. These items may include paints, household cleaners, compact fluorescent lamps (CFL), automotive products, garden chemicals, batteries, electronics, and more.

The materials accepted through this program include:

- Automotive Products**
Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels, and more.
- Garden Chemicals**
Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides, and weed killers.
- Paint Products**
Paint, caulk, glue, stain, stripper, thinner, and wood preservative.
- Household Cleaners**
Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaner, rust remover, tile/shower cleaner, upholstery cleaner, and more.

- Electronics**
Computer, monitor, keyboards, MP3 players, televisions (DVD/CD players, tape players, VCR, cell phones, desk top printers, fax machines, and microwaves).
- Mercury containing items**
Batteries, compact fluorescent lamps, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, and thermostats.

We do not collect ammunition, medicine/medical waste, sharps, explosives, asbestos, tires, or any materials in unlabeled or leaking containers. For program details, contact 1-800-449-7587.



2023 Recycling Program

We are excited to announce the acceptance of plastic tubs in your curbside recycling program. Acceptable plastic tubs have a snap on lid and hold food such as yogurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese, and butter. Plastic tub lids and food must be removed before the container can be recycled.

Waste Management is asking your community to help combat recycling contamination. For programs to be successful, all participants must make an effort to practice good recycling habits

- No plastic bags of any kind will be accepted. Please place material loose in your recycling bin or cart.
- Make sure you are only recycling plastic bottles, jugs, jars and tubs. Any other plastic shape must go in the trash.
- Glass is no longer accepted for curbside recycling - talk to your municipality about local drop off programs.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Shredded paper is not accepted.

Recycling will be collected every-other-week. Place only the acceptable recyclables shown below together in your recycling cart or bin.
